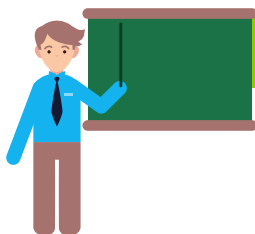

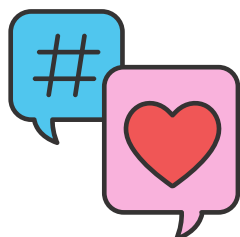

LEVERAGE YOUR INTERESTS
